The Drexel Building Supply Privacy Policy

Your right to privacy is very important. Drexel Building Supply recognizes that when you choose to provide us with information about yourself, you trust us to act responsibly. That's why we have prepared this Privacy Policy to describe the types of personal and non-personal information we collect through our various Web site and through our other business functions, how we use and protect such information, and to whom and under what circumstances we disclose such information. Below is a summary of our Privacy Policy. By using our website and by disclosing information to us in furtherance of our business relationship, you signify your assent to this Privacy Policy to the website Terms of Use when using our website. If you do not agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy or our website Terms of Use, please do not use our website or disclose your personal information to us.

What Information Do We Collect?

Personal Information

In general, Drexel Building Supply collects personal information from you when you voluntarily provide it to us by (1) registering on our website; (2) signing up to enter a promotion, participate in an event or survey, receive newsletters or other literature; (3) making product, project, or service inquiries; and (4) contacting us (including our webmaster, customer service representatives, or other employees) by e-mail or (5) providing other personal information to us in furtherance of our business relationship. In connection with these activities, we may collect personal information from you, including, but not limited to, your name, physical address, e-mail address, age, gender, telephone number, fax number, user name and/or password associated with the use of our website, occupation, company name, name of position within company, whether you are a Drexel Building Supply customer, your primary field of expertise, the type of product you are seeking, the type of project you are or will be working on, the time frame for starting your project, how you heard about Drexel Building Supply, or other information necessary to conduct business with you.

Non-personal information

As part of the standard operation of our website, we may collect/obtain certain non-personal information from you including, but not limited to, your browser type (e.g., Chrome, Firefox or Internet Explorer), operating system (e.g., Windows or Apple), Internet service provider, IP address, website visited, and the domain name from which you accessed the website (e.g., yahoo.com). In addition, we may collect information about your browsing behavior, such as the date and time you visit our website, the areas

or pages of our website that you visit, the amount of time spent viewing our website, the number of times you return to our website, and other click-stream data. We may use cookies to collect this information, which may be combined with your personal information. A cookie is a small text file that may be stored on the hard drive of your computer which enable us to recognize your computer when you return to our website.

You are always free to decline cookies, but in doing so you may not be able to use certain features on our website. The "help" segment of the toolbar on most browsers explains how to configure a browser to not accept new cookies, how to have the browser inform a user when they receive a new cookie, and how to erase cookies from a computer's hard drive.

How Do We Use Your Information?

We may use the information we collect from you for any of the following purposes: (1) to facilitate your use of our website and better understand your needs; (2) to fulfill your requests for information about certain products, services, and projects; (3) to send you information, promotional materials, and offers from our company; (4) to contact visitors to our website when necessary; (5) to help address problems with our websites; (6) to administer our website; (7) to conduct internal reviews of our website (e.g., to determine the number of visitors to specific pages within the site); (8) to help us better understand visitors' use of our website; (9) to protect the security or integrity of our websites; (10) to conduct business with you (including obtaining and disclosing credit and billing information); and (10) for such other purposes provided in this Privacy Policy. Non-personal information will be used for these purposes as well to monitor our website and provide a greater online experience for our visitors.

Will We Disclose Information We Collect From You?

Drexel Building Supply may transfer or otherwise disclose information collected from you to the following entities for the following purposes: (1) to Drexel Building Supply employees, independent contractors, subsidiaries, affiliates, consultants, business associates, service providers, and suppliers, if the disclosure will enable that entity to perform a business, professional, or technical support function for Drexel Building Supply; (2) to employees, independent contractors, service providers, and suppliers of Drexel Building Supply to fulfill a product or service request; and (3) to respond to judicial process and provide information to law enforcement agencies or in connection with an investigation on matters related to public safety, as permitted by law.
